ESJRC program will instruct youth in learning 4 position competitive smallbore rifle shooting. The program will follow the Civilian Marksmanship Program. Youth ages 12 – 19 may participate subject to Instructor approval.

## To participate:

- 1. Athlete must be member of main Everett Sportsmans Club. Cost \$15 Junior Member or \$30 per family
- 2. Athlete must also be member of Junior Rifle Club. Cost \$30 annual + \$10 charge per relay Note: \$10 per relay charge subject to change based on club costs. (extra relays \$5) Multiple family members per relay charge: \$10 first youth, \$5 each additional youth
- 3. Athlete must sign up, complete forms, and pay membership fees at Sign-up night. Sign-up nights are:
  - Monday, September 9, 2019 6:00 7:00 pm at Everett Sportsmans Club
  - Tuesday, September 10, 2019 6:00 7:00 pm at Everett Sportsmans Club
- 4. Athlete must take and complete Everett Sportsman Junior Rifle Club Safety Course \*\*\*\*\* Mandatory !! 2019 Safety Course will be:

Saturday, September 21, 2019 8:00 am to 3:00 pm at the Everett Sportsmans Club Sunday, September 22, 2019 1:00pm to 5:00pm at the Everett Sportsmans Club

- 5. Shooting will take place on Monday or Tuesday evenings at the Everett Sportsmans Club. Once safety course is passed, athlete will be allowed to sign up for a "1 hour" relay on either Monday or Tuesday evenings between 5:30 and 9:30 pm. After initial sign up, switching relay times will only be permitted on a "space available" basis. Shooting will begin on September 30 and October 1, 2019 and will conclude at the end of February with a "season ending match".
